background

Hyundai Motor Company is investing in training facilities and resources for its UK dealers, with the opening of its purpose built 'Hyundai Academy Training Centre' in High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire. The requirement for the Academy is to improve further the learning environment and delegate experience for all who attend the facility.

Working with Hyundai Motor UK, space-pod has been able to design and build a purpose-built environment, which will provide the hub for all Hyundai Academy operations, the large majority of training, both technical and commercial. The facility has been fitted out with eight training rooms including a dedicated computer room, a technical training workshop, a mock showroom for sales and after-sales training and a large eatery area.

the scope of the work provided by space-pod was:

- > Scheme Design & CAD planning.
- > Construction of internal walls, glass partitioning schemes & storage-wall systems.
- > Installation of acoustic folding partitions and ceiling systems.
- > Lighting, air conditioning, electrics and plumbing.
- > Interior colour scheme including decoration and carpets.
- > Corporate branding, including bespoke, digitally printed wall coverings.
- > Glass door and glass partition signage.
- > Installation of bespoke eatery and changing room facilities
- > 14 vehicle workshop/technical area
